KA101 school education staff mobility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deadline for applications: 2/02/2017 -12:00 Bxl time • Eligible participating organisations – the same, except: a national mobility consortium. • Who can apply – the same, except a national mobility consortium • Number of participating organisations: A mobility activity is transnational and involves minimum one participating organisation from Serbia and one participating organisation from an Erasmus+ Programme Country. Receiving organisations do not need to be identified at the time of applying for a grant. • Other criteria in general eligibility criteria do not apply.
KA102 VET learners and staff mobility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deadline for applications: 2/02/2017 -12:00 Bxl time • Without the VET charter • Eligible participating organisations – the same • Who can apply – the same, except the coordinator of a national mobility consortium - eligible: A VET organisation (or its subsidiary/branch) established in Serbia sending learners and staff abroad. • Number of participating organisations: A mobility activity is transnational and involves minimum one participating organisation from Serbia and one participating organisation from an Erasmus+ Programme Country. • Other criteria in general eligibility criteria do not apply.
KA104 Adult education staff mobility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deadline for applications: 2/02/2017 -12:00 Bxl time • Eligible participating organisations – the same, • Who can apply – the same, except the coordinator of a national mobility consortium of non-vocational education - eligible: A non-vocational adult education organisation established in Serbia, sending its staff abroad • Number of participating organisations: During the implementation of the mobility project, minimum two organisations: one from Serbia (sending) and one from a different Erasmus+ Programme country (receiving) must be involved. <p>Only the sending organisation needs to be identified at the time of applying for a grant.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Other criteria in general eligibility criteria do not apply.

<p>KA105 Youth mobility</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deadline for applications: 2/02/2017 -12:00 Bxl time • Eligible activities: Youth Exchanges; European Voluntary Service – no mobility of youth workers <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Eligible participating organisations – the same, except a group of young people active in youth work • Who can apply – the same, except a group of young people active in youth work • Number of participating organisations: A mobility activity is transnational and involves at least two participating organisations: from Serbia and at least one from an Erasmus+ Programme country. If a Youth mobility project foresees only one activity, the coordinator must also act either as sending or receiving organisation except if the activity is a European Voluntary Service. If a youth mobility project foresees more than one activity, the project coordinator can – but not necessarily has to – act as sending organisation or receiving organisation. In all cases, the coordinator must be an organisation established in Serbia. Only the sending organisation needs to be identified at the time of applying for a grant. <p>Additional eligibility criteria for youth exchanges: Maximum number of participants in Youth exchanges is 40 instead of 60. <p>KA202 SP in VET</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Deadline for applications: 29/03/2017 -12:00 Bxl time for projects for projects starting between 1 September and 31 October of the same year. • Eligible activities: Blended mobility of learners Long-term teaching or training assignments Short-term joint staff training assignments • Eligible participating organisations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ≡ a school/institute/educational centre for vocational education and training); ≡ a non-profit organisation, association, NGO; ≡ a public or private, a small, medium or large enterprise (including social enterprises); ≡ a public body at local, regional or national level; ≡ a social partner or other representative of working life, including chambers of commerce, industry, craft/professional associations and trade unions; ≡ a research institute; ≡ a foundation; ≡ an inter-company training centre; ≡ enterprises providing shared training (collaborative training); ≡ a cultural organisation, library, museum; ≡ a body providing career guidance, professional counselling and information services; ≡ a body validating knowledge, skills and competences acquired through non-formal and informal learning. • Who can apply Any participating organisation established in Serbia can be the applicant. This organisation applies on behalf of all participating organisations involved in the project. • Number of participating organisations: A Strategic Partnership is transnational and involves minimum one organisation from Serbia and two organisations from different Erasmus+ Programme Countries. There is no maximum number of participating organisations. However, the budget for project management and implementation is capped (and equivalent to 10 participating organisations). All participating organisations must be identified at the time of applying for a grant.
