Common features of the differences:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• One selection round</li> <li>• Duration of the projects is shortened up to 1 year in KA1 and up to 22 months in KA2</li> <li>• Only applicants from Serbia can apply</li> <li>• Only projects with E+ Programme Countries</li> <li>• Only mobility flows from Serbia, except for Youth (incoming and outgoing)</li> <li>• No OLS for the period of preparatory measures</li> </ul>
KA101 school education staff mobility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Deadline for applications: 1/02/2018 -12:00 BXL time</li> <li>• Eligible participating organisations – the same, except: a national mobility consortium.</li> <li>• Who can apply – the same, except a national mobility consortium</li> <li>• Number of participating organisations: A mobility activity is transnational and involves minimum one participating organisation from Serbia and one participating organisation from an Erasmus+ Programme Country. Receiving organisations do not need to be identified at the time of applying for a grant.</li> </ul>
KA102 VET learners and staff mobility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Deadline for applications: 1/02/2018 -12:00 BXL time</li> <li>• Without the VET charter</li> <li>• Eligible participating organisations – the same</li> <li>• Who can apply – the same, except the coordinator of a national mobility consortium - eligible: A VET organisation (or its subsidiary/branch) established in Serbia sending learners and staff abroad.</li> <li>• Number of participating organisations: A mobility activity is transnational and involves minimum one participating organisation from Serbia and one participating organisation from an Erasmus+ Programme Country.</li> </ul>
KA104 Adult education staff mobility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Deadline for applications: 1/02/2018 -12:00 BXL time</li> <li>• Eligible participating organisations – the same,</li> <li>• Who can apply – the same, except the coordinator of a national mobility consortium of non-vocational education - eligible: A non-vocational adult education organisation established in Serbia, sending its staff abroad</li> <li>• Number of participating organisations: During the implementation of the mobility project, minimum two organisations: one from Serbia (sending) and one from a different Erasmus+ Programme country (receiving) must be involved.</li> </ul> <p>Only the sending organisation needs to be identified at the time of applying for a grant.</p>

<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Youth mobility</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Deadline for applications:15/02/2018 -12:00 BXL time</li> <li>• Eligible activities: Youth Exchanges; Volunteering activities, Mobility of youth workers</li> </ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Eligible participating organisations – the same</li> <li>• Who can apply – the same,</li> <li>• Number of participating organisations: A mobility activity is transnational and involves at least two participating organisations: from Serbia and at least one from an Erasmus+ Programme country. If a Youth mobility project foresees only one activity, the coordinator must also act either as sending or receiving organisation. If a youth mobility project foresees more than one activity, the project coordinator can – but not necessarily has to – act as sending organisation or receiving organisation. In all cases, the coordinator must be an organisation established in Serbia.</li> </ul> <p>Only the sending organisation needs to be identified at the time of applying for a grant.</p> <p>Additional eligibility criteria for youth exchanges:  Maximum number of participants in Youth exchanges is 40.  Maximum number of participants in Youth workers -up to 20 participants (including, where relevant, trainers and facilitators) in each activity planned by the project.  Participants from the country of the receiving organisation must be involved in each activity.</p>
